Dear Parents,

Welcome back! I hope you all had a fantastic summer break. PE on Tuesdays and Wednesdays

Our learning this term

Reading

We are beginning our reading lessons with the fantastic Shakleton's Journey and then will be moving onto The Secrets of a Sun King later in the term.

English

We will start by writing third person stories from another culture before moving onto writing a balanced argument, formal letters of application and poetry that uses word play.

Maths

In maths we will be reasoning with large whole numbers, exploring integer addition and subtraction and then moving onto multiplication and division. We will also have a weekly arithmetic test which consist of 10 questions and then we have a monthly 40 question arithmetic test in preparation for Year 6. Daily precision timetables and TTRS will also continue this year.

Wider Curriculum

We are going to begin the year with learning about Ancient Greece in history and looking at UK countries in geography. In science we will be looking at properties of materials and then changes in animals and humans. Do ask your children about all of the other exciting units we are studying this term!

Homework

Home learning will be uploaded via Showbie by the end of the day on Fridays and will be collected the following Friday. Their tasks will include spellings, precision times tables, a maths or an English task and a knowledge organiser to revise. In addition to this, the children will be expected to practise TTRS every day during the week and read for approximately 20mins daily. Now that the children are in Year 5, I would really like to see them taking ownership and responsibility for completing their homework. When reading daily at home, please ensure that it is recorded by either an adult or your child in their reading records. It is so important that the children come to school with their reading books and records every day and that they are not left at home.
